Panel Discussion Covers International Document Review

The panel also included Kurt Michel, president of Content Analyst Company and Ian Campbell, COO of iConect Development.

"Increased enforcement of the Foreign Corrupt Practices Act means that companies need to be better able to investigate possible violations and react to government investigations. Important evidence is often found in electronic documents, which may reside anywhere in the world," said Chris May. "We were pleased to help the audience understand these specific challenges and provide some tips for managing electronically stored information within the context of FCPA investigations."
