IE Discovery Announces InfoDox™ Platform Upgrade

Features Bring Additional Efficiency to Legal Reviews

Austin, Texas (May 1, 2006)—Responding to the ever-changing requirements of legal document reviews, IE Discovery, a leading provider of comprehensive Discovery Management solutions, today released a upgrade of its flagship technology platform for immediate availability.

Created to increase the efficiency of legal reviewers, the InfoDox upgrade features a new Compare Document interface for determining duplicates and a Document Viewer that displays the best available representation of the document, including image, text, or native file.

Compare Documents

With the Compare Document feature, reviewers evaluate document images side-by-side to determine if duplicates exist. The ability to quickly decide duplicate documents is an increasingly important time- and cost-saving enhancement, especially for today's expansive discovery collections containing millions of electronic and paper documents.

Legal reviewers can now devote their valuable time to analyzing documents instead of performing duplicative work. The feature reduces the amount of time necessary to perform a review: once determining a duplicate, the reviewer uses the Compare Document feature to move the duplicate outside of the reviewable pool. This feature also ensures consistency across the document collection—if you mark a document as relevant or privilege, all duplicates should have identical attributes, thus eliminating differences subject to reviewer error.

“With the new Comparison Viewer feature in InfoDox the days of playing *Concentration* are over. Document reviewers are no longer limited to comparing two documents at a time,” said Sue Seeley, IE Discovery's Legal Services Group Manager.



“We are now able to compare multiple hard-copy images or entire e-mail master-attachment families at a time, side-by-side. The result has been a much more efficient, cost-effective means of comparing documents for purposes of removing duplicates from a document collection. This has been particularly valuable when we have needed to compile an agency administrative record.”

Duplicate identification is essential when reviewing e-mails and e-mail attachments that potentially contain a high number of duplicates. For example, one e-mail chain with 10 recipients that contains a Word file attachment could spawn hundreds of duplicates in the collection, depending on how many times the message was forwarded. The Compare Document feature enables reviewers to select and open specific members of the image’s attachment family to determine if these are also duplicates.

The Compare Document feature is a highly customizable interface to accommodate individual user preferences and optimize productivity. Reviewers can analyze multiple document images and synchronize the image viewer options—including zooming, panning, and navigating pages—of all the displayed document images. As an example, the reviewer can examine the lower left corner of five documents while zoomed in at 150 percent.

Document Viewer

The new Document Viewer in ReviewDox displays the best available representation of the document, such as the text of the document or the native file, if an image is not available. For example, if the application cannot locate an image, the Document Viewer displays the original document or text file of the same document. The new enhancement saves reviewers from opening a text window or attempting to download the native file.
